POLICY No. 202 PROGRAM

CURRICULUM/ASSESSMENT

Although the Board of Trustees has ultimate responsibility for district curriculum and common assessment systems, the Board relies upon the Educational Services Department for initial development of curriculum and common assessments. The Educational Services Department shall be responsible for:

- 1. Monitoring compliance with state and federal curriculum and educational requirements;
- 2. Providing leadership to the schools individually and district -wide;
- 3. Coordinating planning and the decision-making so that a common direction of action is provided for the District;
- 4. Developing, reviewing, and approving the District's curriculum and common assessment systems, subject to the overall authority of the Board;
- 5. Working with principals and teachers in adapting the curriculum and common assessments to meet the learning needs of all students;
- 6. Sharing information between and among all school sites on effective research based practices; and
- 7. Communicating to the schools information that affects implementation of district-wide curriculum and common assessment systems.
