**WITHDRAWAL FROM SCHOOL: ADULT EDUCATION PROGRAM**

Nevada law requires enrollment in school until age 18. It is the responsibility of the schools, along with parents and guardians to encourage students to complete their educational program. Further, it is the responsibility of the schools, parents and guardians to assist students in reaching career goals and to inform them of various alternatives to withdrawal.

Whenever a student wishes to withdraw from school (as opposed to transferring to another educational institution), the following actions shall be taken:

1. Counsel the student regarding personal and vocational goals;
2. Provide the student with information regarding alternatives to withdrawal which may be made available within the existing educational system;
3. Inform the student of the opportunities for education available through completion of the high school equivalency examination program;
4. Point out to the student the opportunities for education available in the armed forces;
5. Inform the student of the relative potential for success of students who complete particular educational programs as compared to those who drop out of school; and,
6. Make every effort to satisfy the student's future educational needs.

The District has established an Adult Education program, consistent with the requirements of the Nevada Administrative Code ("NAC") and statutes for students 18 years of age or older who complete the educational requirements established by the NAC and desire to obtain a diploma. Students who are 17 years of age, but less than 18 years of age and who participate in an alternative program for education of students at risk of dropping out of school (pursuant to NRS 388.537) may enroll in the adult education program with the approval of the Board of Trustees, upon application made pursuant to this Regulation, using the forms attached to this Regulation.
