POLICY No. 710 PROPERTY

TOBACCO FREE SCHOOL DISTRICT FACILITIES

It is the policy of Carson City School District (the "District") that smoking and the use of tobacco products of any kind, including "vapor" or "e-cigarettes", or similar device is prohibited in all buildings, on all grounds, and all property of the District. For purposes of this policy, District property includes any building used for instruction, administration, support services, maintenance, parking, loading docks, or storage. District property also includes all school grounds, playing fields, playgrounds, and District-owned vehicles. This policy applies to all students, employees, volunteers, and the public.

Enforcement

Students and District staff will be subject to disciplinary action for violations of this policy. Members of the general public who use tobacco products, including "vapor" or "e-cigarettes", or any manufactured device that produces a vapor that simulates smoking will be expected to comply with this policy.

Students

All violations of this policy by students shall be referred to a building administrator.

A student is considered to be in violation of this policy either through possession or use of tobacco products, including "vapor" or "e-cigarettes", or similar devices in/on District property. For a first offense, students will be issued a tobacco contract, and for a second offense, students will receive a 3 day suspension.

Staff

Appropriate disciplinary actions will be implemented regarding employees who smoke or use tobacco products, including "vapor" or "e-cigarettes", or similar devices in/on District property.

Public

Signs making it clear to the public that smoking is prohibited will be displayed in areas most often used by community groups. Individuals who are observed smoking in/on District property will be informed of this policy and their cooperation requested.

Individuals or groups using District property who fail to adhere to this policy will have their authorization to use District property revoked.
