REGULATION No. 216 PROGRAM

TITLE I COMPARABILITY

To ensure textbook/supply expenditure and staffing comparability among Title I and non-Title I schools, the Associate Superintendents of Human Resources and Educational Services will review staffing allocations and text-supply expenditures each year. Each year, one of the two following methods must be used:

Method A

- 1. Elementary project schools shall be compared only against elementary non project schools.
- 2. Middle School project schools shall be compared only against middle school non project schools.

These comparisons will ensure that elementary Title I schools are comparable in staffing and curriculum materials/instructional supplies

or

Method B

The District will demonstrate comparability by comparing the average of all non Title I schools (except the high school) against each Title I school in either of two areas:

- 1. Average number of students per instructional staff, or
- 2. Average instructional staff salary expenditure per student.

After a review of the data, any instances where comparability is not in evidence will be corrected.

These corrections will be reflected in the annual Title I Comparability Report that shall be submitted to the Nevada Department of Education by the state required deadline.
