REGULATION No. 515.1 STUDENTS

STUDENT EDUCATION RECORDS

Confidentiality of Health and Welfare Information

School personnel involved in observation, examination or evaluation of students, or in making related reports, shall not disclose to any person the name or address of a student with physical, mental, educational or social disabilities, nor data resulting from such observation, examination or evaluation, except where such disclosure is duly authorized by District procedures or by a written request of the student's parent or guardian. Information in a student's educational and health records shall be regarded as confidential.

A person or agency who requests educational records for the District, shall not disclose the education records, except to the extent authorized by applicable federal and state laws, and regulations, including, without limitations, 20 U.S.C. § 1232g and 34 C.F.R. Part 99.
