POLICY No. 215 PROGRAM

EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

The Board believes that the goals and objectives of this District are best achieved by a diversity of learning experiences, some of which are more appropriately conducted outside the regular classroom curricular program of the school.

The purpose of such extra-curricular activities shall be:

- 1. To develop student initiative and provide for the exercise of responsibility.
- 2. To develop leadership capacities and good organizational skills, and
- 3. To enable students to explore a wider range of individual interests than might be available in the regular curricular program.

For purposes of this policy, "extra-curricular activities" shall be those activities which are sponsored or approved by the Board of Education but are not offered for credit toward graduation. Such activities shall ordinarily be conducted wholly or partly outside the regular school day and marked by student participation in the processes of initiation, planning, organizing and execution through the Student Council.

The District shall make school facilities, supplies and equipment available and assign staff members for the support of a program of extra-curricular activities. No extra-curricular activity shall be considered to be under the sponsorship of the Board unless it has been approved by the Superintendent.
