POLICY No. 201 PROGRAM

EDUCATIONAL RESEARCH

The professional advancement of an educational institution depends to a significant degree upon the proper development of effective research practices as well as the successful application of research findings. Improvements both of management and instructional functions require knowledge of current and prior research studies and of their implications for teaching and learning.

It is the policy of the Board of Trustees to encourage a spirit of inquiry and investigation and to urge the development of academic research projects to further the educational body of knowledge, as well as improve the quality of education provided to Carson City School District students. The Superintendent, therefore, is authorized to establish within the Educational Services Department the necessary resources to provide educational research services.

The Associate Superintendent of Educational Services shall establish and maintain liaisons with other agencies, institutions, and organizations engaged in research studies of significance to the District.
