EVALUATION OF EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM

The Board of Trustees shall administer state and federally mandated examinations such as proficiency and end of course examinations as prescribed by the State Board of Education.

The results of such examinations may be released by the Superintendent or his or her designee. Parents may obtain an explanation of the results of their child's test from qualified school personnel.

The Superintendent shall use federal, state and district indicators to review student progress and make recommendations in programming and staffing designed to further the educational objectives of the District.

The Superintendent or his or her designee shall complete a yearly evaluation of school performance for each school within the District. Results of this evaluation will be shared with the Board on an annual basis. Staff shall utilize the data gained from this process to diagnose and remedy deficiencies and provide enhancement opportunities to improve the performance of individual students.
