Ahoy, Seeliger Families! Kindergarten registration for the 2024-2025 school year will begin on Monday, March 4th! *Please remember that your child must be 5 years old on or before August 1, 2024 to be enrolled in Kindergarten*. Registrations will be by appointment beginning on Monday, March 4th, and will continue daily between 9 am and 2 pm until the end of the school year in June. Please make your registration appointment anytime by calling the office at 283-2200.

At your appointment, you will need to provide:

- * your child's birth certificate
- * current immunization records
- * proof of Seeliger residency (utility bill in your name or a rental/mortgage statement)
- * your photo ID

Additionally, the window to complete online registration for *new* students, <u>as well as annual registration updates for existing students</u> will open on Monday, March 4th, Updates for existing students will require a parent to log in with a username and password. If you need assistance with this, please call 283-2200.

Seeliger Elementary is beginning a Pre-Kindergarten program in the 2024-2025 school year! Children must be 4 years old by August 1, 2024 to be eligible for the program. The registration process will be handled by Student Support Services, NOT at Seeliger. You may call Student Support at 775-283-2350 for more information.

We hope to see you at Spring Parent Teacher Conferences on March 21 & 22. Then after Spring Break comes our statewide test, the <u>SBAC</u>. Please help by making sure students get a good night's rest so they can be alert for testing! We need your child here and on time so please help us with attendance during testing season!

Finally, please remember that the circular driveways in front of the school are active loading areas for picking up children after school. <u>Parents are asked to stay in their vehicles while waiting for students, and to move your vehicle forward in line as other parents leave the area.</u> Thank you for your attention to this safety reminder.
