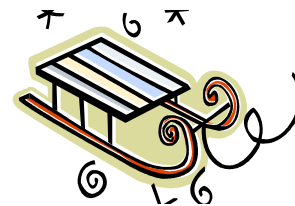
PRINCIPALS' TREASURE

LET'S TALK ABOUT TARDIES AND SCHOOL SAFETY!

Parents, we need you to make every effort to ensure that your children are here on campus **before** 8:25 am daily when the first bell rings. At that time, teachers take their classes into their classrooms, and there is no supervision on the playground before the gates are locked shortly after. If your child arrives after 8:25, he/she should enter through the front office, NOT the playground gates. Tardy slips are given beginning at 8:30, and students must be accompanied by a parent to be excused if they arrive at 8:30 or after.

Please be aware that the School District's Truancy Officer is helping us look more closely at our chronically tardy and absent students. We do ask that you keep your children home when they are ill; otherwise students should be at school every day, on time, for the full school day whenever possible.
