Tights/leggings under skirts: Plain white or black. ****No leggings without skirt/shorts over them****

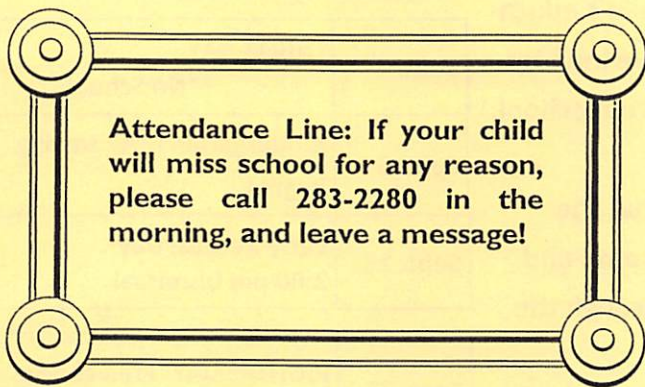
Shirts: Short or long-sleeved solid polos in red, white or navy blue. During cooler weather, a white or black turtle-neck may be worn under polo.
