II. <u>Project</u>

Description of the Construction: This project consists of the demolition and construction of the existing restrooms from a gendered type layout into a general use type layout at Carson High School, located at 1111 Saliman Road, Carson City, Nevada. There are four restroom

blocks located in the central circulation core of the High School, two on each floor, with two blocks at the north end, and two blocks at the south end. There will also be moderate remodeling of space adjacent to the blocks, consisting of wall and ceiling finishes. Materials, finishes, HVAC, plumbing, lighting and electrical systems will be determined during the Design Phase of the project. Construction logistics will play a key part of the delivery. The majority of the work is to be done during the summer, with minor finishing completed while school is in session.

* <u>SCHEDULE</u>: Remodel of the eight (8) bathrooms at Carson High School shall begin on June 3, 2024 with the issuance of the Notice to Proceed. The four (4) south bathrooms are to be completed on or before August 12, 2024 when the start of school begins. The construction end date for the Bathroom Remodel for the north bathrooms will be targeted for October 14, 2024. This will be an active campus after school starts on August 12, 2024 until the completion date targeted for October 14, 2024.

The CMAR agrees that time is of the essence of this Agreement and further agrees to satisfactorily complete the work in accordance with the contract documents within the specified contract time plus any adjustments to the contract time resulting from approved Change Orders, and failing to do so, agrees to pay, not as a penalty, but as liquidated damages, the sum stipulated below for each calendar day in excess of the contract time stipulated in this Agreement. Liquidated damages shall cease to be assessed on the date of Substantial Completion provided the CMAR completes all punch-list work within the time limit stipulated in the Certificate of Substantial Complete all punch-list work within the time limit stipulated in the CMAR does not complete all punch-list work within the time limit stipulated in the Certificate of Substantial Completion.

- 2. This is a Public Works Project that will be complying with Prevailing Wage and Apprenticeship Utilization requirements
- 3. There is no asbestos or lead in the areas being demolished. Wise Consulting has performed tests and the reports are online as Exhibit G-1, G-2, & G-3. No abatement will be required.
- 4. There will be no summer school in the Main Building, summer school will be located in the Tech Center during construction. The Front Office will be open in the summer.
- 5. You do not need to stagger. Construction can take place on both restrooms at the same time.
- 6. You can work extra hours and weekends, as needed. It will need to be coordinated with CCSD. It is strictly up to the CMAR. The CMAR may possibly start earlier with the restrooms that are locked and not used during the school session in May 2024.
- 7. Work will be on-going during the timeframe of when school resumes, August 12, 2024.
- 8. The walls are block and we will be calling for epoxy floors. New walls will be metal studs with mold and mildew resistant gypsum board or tile backer. Finish to be applied is TBD.
- 9. Firewalls will need reconfiguration. Some lockers will be removed from the outside wall.

- 10. The demo and lay down area will be available in the teacher's parking lot. There will also be an area in the back.
- 11. The sanitary sewer is between the 2 walls. It is identified in the plans.
- 12. A dumpster is allowed for garbage and demo materials. A CMAR trailer will be put in a specific area so it won't need to be moved once school resumes.
- 13. Existing north / south side of elevator shaft walls are 4" expansion joints and east / west sides are 3".
- 14. There are two elevators available for the CMAR's use.
- 15. The doors in the wrestling room has a forklift door.
- 16. The restrooms have minimal expansion joints.
