Starting in August 2017, CCSD began the RFP process, once the RFP process was completed the team reviewed the textbooks. Based on the rubric scoring the committee determined that publisher presentations were not necessary to determine the appropriate textbook for the Physics department. By following these steps, the committee determine that Physics by Houghton, Mifflin, Harcourt is best aligned with the NVACS and NGSS standards, and with the curriculum that was developed by the Physics department at Carson High School.

Of all the materials that was provided and reviewed by the Physics committee the resources from HMH Physics was determined to best align and support CCSD student's in meeting the requirements of both CCSD and NGSS learning standards.
