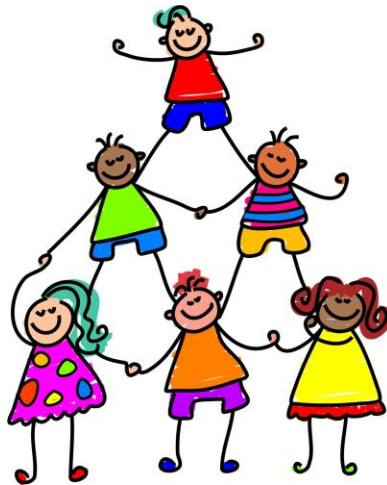



Taking time to PLAN your project is very important for success. Your PLAN serves as the framework for your project, keeping you organized and on track.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

You probably know that water is necessary to every form of life on our planet, but have you ever wondered where it's been before it reaches your tap or your hose? Would you be surprised to learn that water is always moving on, under, and even above Earth's surface? Did you know that some scientists study water for a career? If you like science and are interested in the role water plays on our planet, you can learn how water changes forms during what is called the "water cycle" or the "hydrologic cycle," and then make a model to demonstrate how it works. You can also investigate the distribution of Earth's water and create an online graph to include in your slides about Earth's water. See the INTENDED PRODUCT tab of this project for more product ideas.

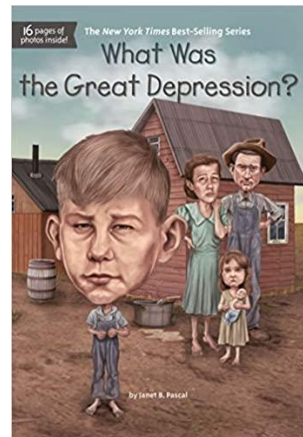

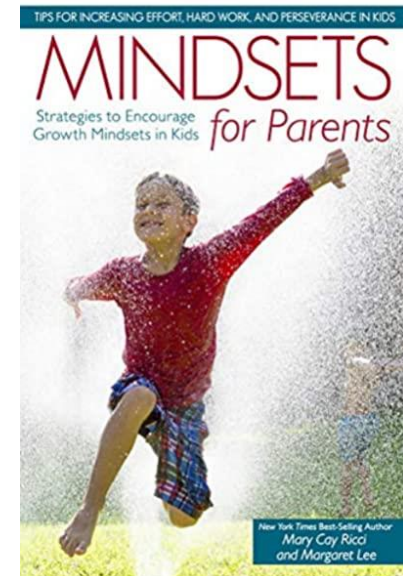

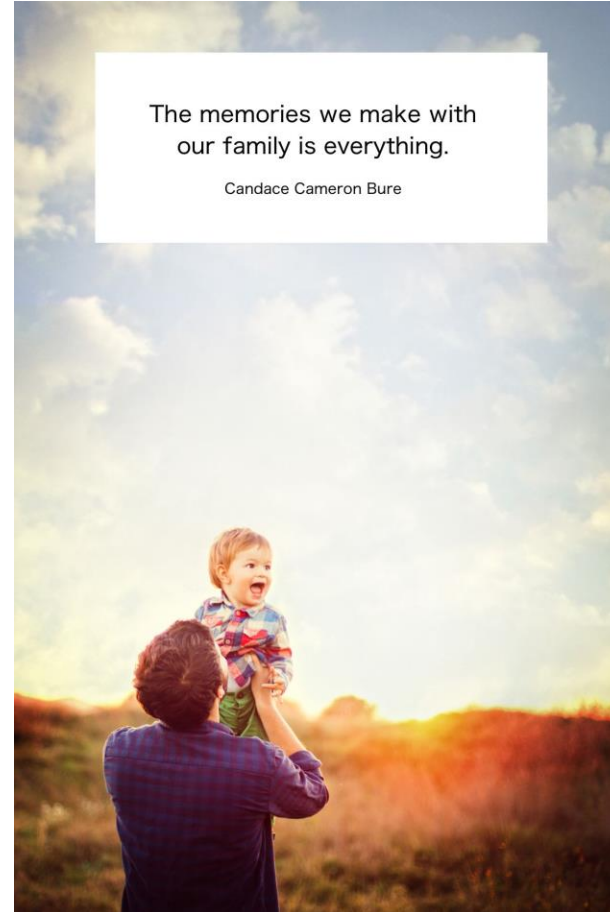
